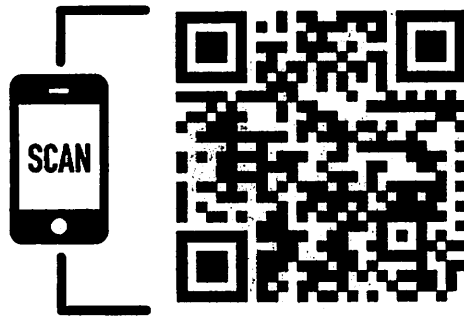


Guest parking rules:

Please note any vehicle exceeding this time frame will not be able to register as a guest and will be subject to being towed or being immobilized at the vehicle owner's expense.



Coral Gardens II

The Following Violations will result in the immediate towing of a vehicle at the owners' expense:

- Parking in Fire Lanes
- Parking in a designated handicapped area without proper placard or handicap license plate.
- Parking in designated "No Parking Area"
- Parked in a manner that blocks the trash gates, blocks other cars or vehicles that are parked in a manner that impedes the use of more than one parking space.
- Parking on a sidewalk or grassy area.
- Commercial Vehicles, Cargo Vans, Boats, Trailers, Recreational Vehicles and any other type of vehicle or vessel prohibited by the Association as well as any vehicle that cannot be parked completely within a designated parking space without impeding access to other parking spaces, thoroughfares or drives. (Note temporary parking during daytime hours or while providing services to a unit is allowed)
- Any vehicle parked in a space assigned to another unit owner.
- Vehicles with expired License Plates and/or expired registrations and/or expired insurance.
- Improperly parked guest vehicles
- Vehicles with altered License Plates /altered decals

The Following Violations will result in towing and/or booting of vehicles after 24 hours (note that only one warning will be issued repeat violations with the same vehicle will result in immediate towing):

- Inoperable vehicles, including but not limited to vehicles with flat tires, oil leaks or broken windows
- Vehicles without any License Plates

Permit must be placed on the inside lower left corner of the front window.
